As seniors, all graduation requirements must be fulfilled when enrolled full time at McFatter... times based on the post-secondary schedule.

Students enrolling in any Health Science Education program may be required to undergo a Level II criminal background check and drug screening, per the Joint Commission of Healthcare Organizations. In order to comply with this <u>and</u> clinical rotation requirements, prospective students must have a valid social security number.

Students beginning senior year may not be able to complete due to the length of the selected program.

Grades:

Students must maintain a minimum of a 2.0 unweighted grade point average at their home school and in their technical program. Additionally, students must maintain a 70% or higher in their technical program. Failing a course will result in a withdrawal from the technical program.

Students are expected to submit assignments on time. Grades for late submissions are at the discretion of the instructor.

Attendance/ Report of Absence:

Poor attendance will affect grades and success in the technical program.

If a student is absent 6 or more times in a marking period, the student will be withdrawn from the technical program and assigned back to their home school. Additionally, excessive tardies will result in a withdrawal from the technical program.

Students will not leave campus outside of dismissal time. Students found leaving campus will be awarded consequences as outlined on the Broward County Discipline Matrix. This includes withdrawal from the technical program.

If students are to be dismissed from McFatter Technical College before the technical block is over, an authorized person must report to the High School Student Services Office to complete the sign out process. Please remember that a photo ID is required to take a student off campus.

Per BCPS sign out policy, whoever is an authorized person picking up a student MUST come into the High School Student Services Office.

No sign-outs are permitted after 3:40pm per Broward School Board Policy. This also limits interruptions to the classroom. Please plan appointments, whenever possible, outside of school hours.

Professionalism:

ID badges must be worn at all times. The first ID badge is free; replacement badges will be \$8.00 each. Students will receive their initial ID badge during the first few weeks of school.

The dress code follows Broward School Board Policy. Some programs require specific uniforms to be worn. The technical instructors will notify students of any such requirements when they begin the technical program.

Cell phones are not permitted to be used during class.

Students are expected to conduct themselves professionally, and be respectful to their instructors, classmates, and property. Students violating this expectation will be withdrawn from the technical program.

Students are expected to attend the hours of scheduled instruction, participate in all class activities, and complete and submit assignments in a timely manner.

Students are required to comply with the School Board of Broward County (SBBC) Attendance Policy and the Student Code of Conduct Handbook.

Transportation:

Bus transportation is not guaranteed. Transportation is typically provided to Nova High School, South Plantation High School, and Western High School. If you have questions or concerns regarding transportation, please contact 754-321-5785.

On Early Release Days, Professional Study Days, and Final Exam Half days, you must provide your own transportation as bus transportation is not provided on these days.

Student Drivers and Parking:

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Students who drive to school must register their vehicle and obtain a parking permit. You must provide a copy of your driver's license, vehicle registration, insurance, and payment of \$25.00 to the McFatter High School Student Services Office.
